April's Note on the History of the Parish By Kathleen Norris

The rite of Confirmation was first held at St Clement's on 20 April, 1902. Among the group of twentythree were many who had worked hard to establish the parish. Among them were Mrs. Victoria Ward and her two daughters. (Honolulu's Ward Avenue, Ward Centre, and new Ward Village are named for her family, and she is buried at the small Makiki Cemetery at Pensacola and Wilder).

We're often tempted to think that what we've experienced in our lives is "the way we've always done it." But history has a good way of refuting that assumption. In the early years of the Parish, the Holy Eucharist was held at 7 AM every day. Harriet Neal notes that Mrs. Usborne was frequently the only parishioner present. On Sundays, Morning Prayer with a sermon was held at 11 AM, preceded by Sunday school.

Morning and evening prayer were held daily at 7:30, with some laymen, often including two founders of the parish, Tom May and Thomas Rain Walker, assisting with the readings. Harriet Neal notes that "Canon Usborne usually made an address at evening prayer, and at the end of the service he invited the entire congregation to the [then onsite] rectory for refreshment and conversation."

By the mid-1920's attendance at the evening prayer had become so small that the service was dropped, but the tradition of gathering to share food and socialize continued. With COVID waning, I think we can all be glad to see this tradition being restored as an important part of our parish life.






