Sometimes at the end of the day when my body is tired and my mind is worn out, I seek the deepness of other's words to pray. Two of my favorite prayers are written for the end of the day.

One is in the Book of Common Prayer service of Compline. I often say that Compline is the good night service of the church. Many people read or say the service of compline just before bedtime. My favorite prayer in that service is found on page 134. It reads

Keep watch, dear Lord, with those who work, or watch, or weep this night, and give your angels charge over those who sleep. Tend the sick, Lord Christ; give rest to the weary, bless the dying, soothe the suffering, pity the afflicted, shield the joyous; and all for your love's sake. Amen.

The other prayer I turn to late at night comes from the New Zealand Prayer Book.

*The night is for stillness.
Let us be still in the presence of God.*

*It is night after a long day.
What has been done has been done;
what has not been done has not been done;
let it be.*

*The night is dark.
Let our fears of the darkness of the world and of our own

Adult Discussion

August 4, 11, and 18 we will be watching *Departures*, an award winning Japanese film with English subtitles. Here is a synopsis: Daigo Kobayashi is a devoted cellist in an orchestra that has just been dissolved and now finds himself without a job. Daigo decides to move back to his old hometown with his wife to look for work and start over. He answers a classified ad entitled "Departures" thinking it is an advertisement for a travel agency only to discover that the job is actually for a "Nokanshi" or "encoffineer," a funeral professional who prepares deceased bodies for burial and entry into the next life. While his wife and others despise the job, Daigo takes a certain pride in his work and begins to perfect the art of "Nokanshi," acting as a gentle gatekeeper between life and death, between the departed and the family of the departed. The film follows his profound and sometimes comical journey with death as he uncovers the wonder, joy and meaning of life and living.

August 25 End of Life Planning: We will be discussing and working together on our own end of life plans, including living wills (what medical procedures do you want at the end of your life), and planning our own Services. Both of these documents are tremendous gifts to your loved ones!

A Gift for St. Clement's School

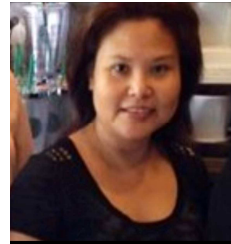

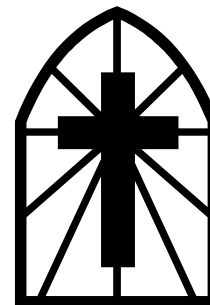
